SAMPLE ITINERARY MUSIC TOUR OF ASIA – SOUTHEAST ASIA

B – Breakfast, L – Lunch, D – Dinner

DAY 1 – ARRIVAL BANGKOK (-)

Welcome to **Bangkok**, the capital of Thailand! Bangkok is a fascinating, exciting and incredible city to visit.

DAY 2 – BANGKOK (B,L,D)

Enjoy a half day cultural tour to see the Grand Palace. The **Grand Palace** is one of the most beautiful samples of an ancient Siamese court. It used to be the residence of the Kings of Thailand. Here you will see palaces which were used for different occasions: the Funeral Palace, the Reception Palace, the Throne Hall, the Coronation Hall, the Royal Guest House, and the beautiful Emerald Buddha Temple.

Participate in the first performance.

Evening, enjoy a welcome dinner.

DAY 3 – BANGKOK (B,L,D)

Discover the unique markets in Bangkok.

Explore the **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market**, a very attractive place to see the old style and traditional way of selling and buying fruits, vegetables, etc., from small boats. You will also see traditional Thai houses, the way they live and travel by boats. The tour includes a visit **to Nakorn Pathom**, site of the highest Chedi in Thailand called "Phra Patom Chedi" which is the largest pagoda in Southeast Asia. Include Rice and Coconut Farm. No boat ride.

Visit one of the kind - **Maeklong Railway Market**. The market set on the middle of train tracks and it disappears when the train running through it.

Return to the city, spend time at the famous **Pratunam Market**, where you will find colorful street food. Shopping at the famous MBK Mall. Enjoy many choices of food at the food court as dinner.

DAY 4 – BANGKOK (B,L,D)

Take a ferry across the **Chao Phraya River**, a scenic river flows through the heart of Bangkok. Visit the **Wat Arun**. Wat Arun is one of Bangkok's most famous temples and is a landmark temple in Bangkok. Wat Arun (nicknamed the 'Temple of Dawn') is partly made up of colorfully decorated spires and stands majestically over the water.

Participate in the second performance.

Dinner at the revolving restaurant and see the night view of Bangkok at the roof top restaurant.

DAY 5 – BANGKOK TO SIEM REAP (B,L,D) 🟹 📟

Fly to **Siem Reap**, Cambodia, which will act as your base during your visit to Angkor, considered by many to be the most spectacular architectural ruins on Earth!

DAY 6 – SIEM REAP (B,L,D)

Constructed between the 9th and 13th centuries, the **Temples of Angkor** were built around the Khmer interpretations of Indian religious and political beliefs that ultimately evolved from Hinduism to Buddhism.



The complex architectural grandeur of the temples is arguably unmatched among the world's ancient ruins. Start your exploration at the best preserved and most famous of all the temples, Angkor Wat, honoring the Hindu god Vishnu. Featuring five trademark towers and stunning bas-reliefs, it has become a symbol of Cambodia.

Next stop is Angkor Thom to see the Bayon Temple. One of the few Buddhist temples in Angkor, it features some 200 striking faces carved in 54 towers and impressive bas-reliefs.

DAY 7 –SIEM REAP (B,L,D) Participate in a **music workshop** at a local village, share the music with the local children. Enjoy the traditional dancing performance by the villagers. Learn about Cambodia culture, ethnic, and Khmer traditional.

Participate in the fourth performance – a festival performance.

This evening, enjoy a traditional Apsara Dance Performance, where the ancient Khmer culture is brought to life by talented dancers, singers, and musicians.

DAY 8 – DEPART SIEM REAP (B)

Your tour ends with breakfast this morning. Transfer to the airport for your flight back to home.
